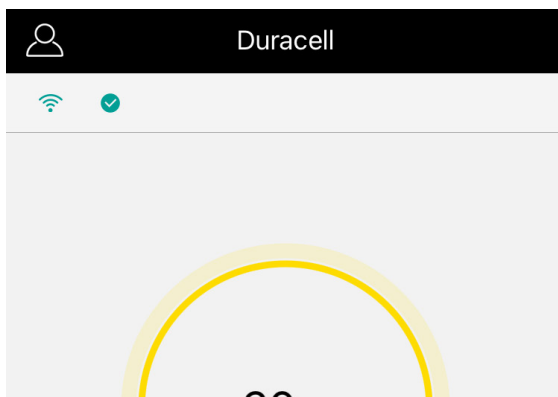


How to Connect Solar Home to Wi-Fi?

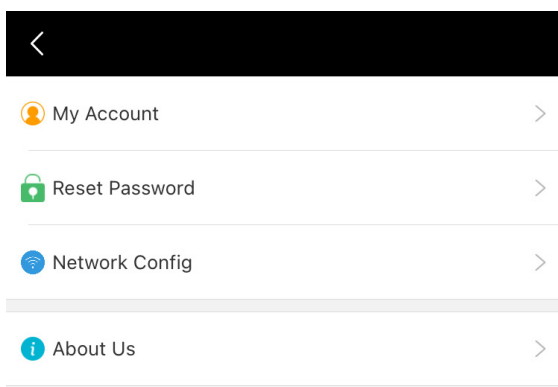
1. Download the **Duracell Solar Home** app from the Apple Store or Google Play onto your mobile device.




2. Open your mobile device and navigate to the Wi-Fi settings.
3. Look for the Wi-Fi broadcast named "DTUP-(device serial number)" and connect your phone to it. Once connected, exit the Wi-Fi settings.
4. Launch the Solar Home app on your mobile device.
5. Tap on your account icon located in the top left corner of the app.



6. Select "Network Config" from the menu to access the Wi-Fi setup.

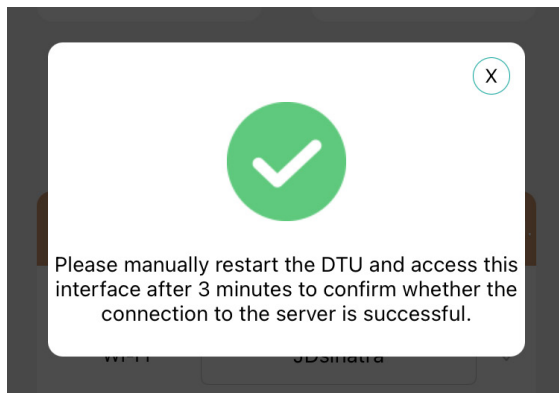


7. Enter your Wi-Fi SSID and Password into the provided fields, then click on "Send to DTU".

10. Reopen the Solar Home app and confirm that the DTU is successfully connected to your Wi-Fi network.
